

Introduction

This qualification specification outlines key information required by learners to ensure they are able to make an informed decision in regard to the qualifications they are undertaking.

Qualification purpose

This qualification is aimed those using ladders and stepladders within their work role. This may include repair and refurbishment operatives and those in related trades. Others undertaking this qualification include those working in logistics, education, retail and hospitality.

Qualification objective

This qualification has the purpose of supporting a role in the workplace.

Pre-requisites

This qualification is aimed at those over 16.

Due to the language of the assessment, it is recommended that learners have sufficient command of the English language in order to understand the assessment and to undertake the recommended assessment methods.

Attendees will be required to demonstrate the safe use of a ladder and/or stepladder and should therefore be physically capable of doing this during the learning and assessment process.

There are no other pre-requisites for this qualification.

Delivery

This qualification is typically delivered in a face-to-face format over a half-day period.

Optional and additional units

There are no additional or related units for this qualification. As a half day course, learners may also wish to undertake another half-day qualification in a related subject, for example the QNUK Level 1 Award in Asbestos Awareness (RQF).
